## MISSION OVERVIEW

Easter Seals Greater Houston provides wrap-around solutions for people of all ages with disabilities and their families, giving them new opportunities to live, learn, work and play in our community.

## IN 2023...

Our Adult Program hosted  $(\mathbf{5}(\mathbf{I}))$  meetings. Our Veterans Program served  $1_2 200$  veterans & family members, trained 1 A service dogs and led  $(\mathbf{5})$  mindfulness groups. Our Housing Program helped clients close on 23 homes. The Caroline School taught **1 S** students, providing 750 hours of quality education. High School High Tech & RAMP helped place 15 paid interns, and  $\mathfrak{A}$  interns traveled to Washington, DC, for national panels. BridgingApps served hosted 200 training events. Our Children's Therapy Program provided 4,425 visits for 120 clients. Our NEW Navigation Program served 45 clients. Our Early Childhood Intervention Program served 7/662 children and provided  $31 \sqrt{2}$  hours of services.



Our Respite Programs provided 187,782 hours of respite for parents and caregivers. Our Emergency Assistance Program distributed of emergency assistance funds. Our Toy/Tech Program hosted (1) Tuesday night Adapted Play Group sessions and added Music & Movement Groups. Our Financial Education Program taught 🕄 🕕 classes and served 950 financial education and coacing clients. Our Camps and Rec. Program hosted  $5_{7}000$  hours of camp and (3)(0)(0) hours of recreation for veterans at ReCenter. Our CLASS and Case Mgmt. Program provided 3, 600 home visits and 5,933 general case management services. Our Mental Health Program provided 3, 600 therapy sessions. Our Employment and Transition Program partnered with IBM to offer clients the IBM SkillsBuild Program. We hired (5)(3) new team members, including 17 interns.
